'Unattended' or 'Direct' Cremation, is a cremation with no funeral ceremony and no attendance by mourners. After the cremation, the remains can be scattered within the grounds of the crematorium, returned to you for safe keeping or for a private internment or scattering.

What's included within Our Services (All bold type defines the differences with other service providers):

- The completion and administration of all necessary paperwork.
- Provisions of a simple wood veneered coffin. We do not charge extra for larger coffins.
- Care of the deceased within our modern and tasteful LOCAL facilities.
- Viewing by appointment at our tasteful modern chapel of rest.
- First offices hygienic treatment and dressing in own clothes if requested.
- Provision of necessary staff for reception at the crematorium.
- Cremation at Ipswich Crematorium (Not transferred to a crematorium that's up to 220 miles away)
- Continuity of service and support from an award winning and professionally qualified Funeral Director.
- Visitations to your home address, if preferred, to discuss the arrangements and complete all necessary paperwork.
- Conveyance of the deceased person into our care, within 20 miles, Mon Frid 9am 5pm\*

## Direct Cremation - F.A.Q.s

- 1. Can I pay my last respects in person? Yes.
- 2. Can I attend the crematorium? No. There will be no service of any kind or attendance allowed by the crematorium.
- 3. My relative has passed away at home/in a nursing home, can you help? Yes.
- 4. Can I collect the ashes? Yes. They can be collected from us within 3 working days of the cremation.
- 5. What else can I do with the ashes? They can be scattered or buried at a location of your choice, stored in an urn or keepsake from our extensive range of memorial jewellery.
- 6. Is this a communal cremation? Absolutely not. In the UK each person is cremated individually.
- 7. **Do you re-use the coffin?** Absolutely not. UK crematoriums only accept people for cremation if they are in a suitable coffin & it cannot be opened once it has been received by the crematorium staff.
- 8. Why is this so cheap? An unattended funeral is far simpler for us, and the crematorium to arrange, as such we can offer Direct Cremation at a substantially lower cost than an Attended Funeral Service.
- 9. What kind of coffin do you provide? We include a traditionally shaped coffin made from MDF covered with a wood grain effect veneer.
