## Our charge for an attended funeral in our service chapel is £1,995.00 (Please note a fee of £325 is applicable to the purchase of a funeral plan)

A service held in our elegantly appointed modern air-conditioned Service Chapel, with seating for up to 35 mourners. This can be followed by an unattended cremation, unattended burial, or repatriation.

## What's included within our services? (All bold type defines the differences with other service providers)

- The completion and administration of all necessary paperwork
- Provision of a simple wood veneer coffin. We do not charge extra for larger coffins.
- Provision of necessary staff at the crematorium
- Care of the deceased within our modern and tasteful LOCAL facilities
- Cremation in Ipswich (Not at a crematorium up to 220 miles away).
- Visitations to our Chapel of Rest Mon Frid, 9am 5pm by appointment.
- Choice of day and time for the cremation, to allow for a family gathering in remembrance.
- Use of our Service Chapel and audio-visual facilities for a funeral service (Max attendance 35 people)
- \*Conveyance of the deceased into our care Mon Frid, 9am 5pm within 20 miles inside office hours\*
- Continuity of service and support from an award winning and professionally qualified funeral director.
- Dressing in own clothes if requested.
- Full first offices and hygienic treatment.
- Visitation at home if preferred to discuss the arrangements and complete all necessary paperwork

For a Chapel Service with Local Unattended Cremation, typical disbursements paid to third parties, and which are in addition to our fees are;

- Celebrant or Minister's fee £240
- Ipswich Borough Council Crematorium fee for a no service cremation £315

## The total cost for a Chapel Service with the third-party fees is, £2,550.00\*

After the cremation, the remains can be scattered in the grounds of the crematorium, or returned for safe keeping, burial, or scattering.

## Unattended Cremation - F.A.Q.s

- 1. Can I attend the crematorium? No. There will be no attendance allowed at the crematorium.
- 2. My relative has passed away at home/in a nursing home, can you help? Yes.
- 3. Can I collect the ashes? Yes. They can be collected from us within 3 working days of the cremation.
- **4.** What else can I do with the ashes? They can be scattered or buried at a location of your choice, stored in an urn or keepsake from our extensive range of memorial jewellery.
- 5. Is this a communal cremation? Absolutely not. In the UK each person is cremated individually.
- **6. Do you re-use the coffin?** Absolutely not. UK crematoriums only accept people for cremation if they are in a suitable coffin & it cannot be opened once it has been received by the crematorium staff.
- 7. What kind of coffin do you provide? We include a simple coffin made from MDF covered with a wood grain foil, with an option to upgrade to other coffins if wished.
